






The profile above has rounded edges and shallow mill lines, creating a lack of definition and a softening of the original design.

Every base moulding has a matching base cap offering height flexibility.






The Early American Collection of mouldings feature subtle and clean lines. In the Colonial Era the most common type of moulding ornamentation was a small 3/8" bead cut into the edge of a piece of wood. It helped to add decoration and simple adornment to the corner of wood posts and pieces of trim. Today, the simple, flat casing and baseboard with the handsome bead on one side offer a Shaker starkness. This collection works very well for Arts & Crafts and Craftsman style interiors.

The base and casings have bold shapes and proud projections and the crown is typically highlighted with a dentil moulding in public and formal spaces.


The Federal style became popular after the Revolutionary War between the 1770's and through the early 1800's. Inspired by English architect Robert Adam, the Federal mouldings are much lighter and more delicate than the bold Georgian Mouldings. The cavetto shapes and simple beads help the moulding to read as more refined in a room.





The Greek Revival collection is a late classical style found between 1820 and 1860. The architecture was inspired by new discoveries in Greece and our realization and association with their spirit of democracy. The mouldings in this period are plain and bold with little decoration. They feature flat faces in an effort to mimic stone. It looks great today as a simple yet bold application, often chosen by those looking for a modern, contemporary look.

Reduction in Trim


Have you heard about architect Robert Adam's Logical Theory of Reduction in Trim? In summary, it's advisable to reserve more intricate moulding details for front entries, foyers, and dining rooms, where you're more likely to entertain guests. It is perfectly acceptable to opt for smaller moulding profiles in second-floor areas or private spaces, such as bedrooms and hallways. Our Classical Moulding collection is truly unique and allows you to follow this theory while maintaining a consistent look and feel, even when ceiling heights vary. We offer every casing in 5-1/2", 4-1/2", and 3-1/2" proportionately scaled replicas. Each base moulding comes with a matching base cap, allowing you to adjust the height. Crown mouldings are available in at least two, if not three, different size options.


Crossetted Corner/Eared Architrave

A decorative embellishment for windows, doors and mantles, most commonly used in Georgian and Greek Revival style interiors. The casings in the KB Classical Collection feature large backbands, ideal for these applications.





Jack Miter

A Jack Miter is a combination of a butt joint and a miter which allows you to maintain a continuous bead in casing and base transitions. It can also be pocket hole screwed, minimizing shrinkage.






























