- The TruStile Art Deco door styles combine modern European design ideas introduced in France with the romance of 1930s Hollywood.








COLONIAL






COTTAGE

- TruStile's Cottage series represents historically accurate door styles in both panel and glass configurations, as well as updated interpretations of the historic designs.








CRAFTSMAN

- Simplicity and quality workmanship define the TruStile Craftsman door collection.








FRENCH COUNTRY






MEDITERRANEAN

- TruStile's Mediterranean collection brings the richness and charm of Italian living to your home.








SPANISH COLONIAL










TRADITIONAL

Traditional design often reflects the common sense principles of practicality and functionality.

- TruStile's Traditional series reflects the classic and historic design ideas of an earlier time and place.








TUDOR

- Inspired by English manor homes, the TruStile Tudor series features an assortment of elegant designs and gentle arches.








VICTORIAN

- The ornate nature of the TruStile Victorian door line effectively reproduces this historic time period within your home.


